**TOWN OF CHESTER  
NO THRU TRUCKING  
BY-LAW**

In accordance with RSA 47:17 "By-Laws and Ordinances" Section VIII "Traffic Devices and Signals", and as warranted in the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Part II "Signs" Section 2-B-28 "Selective Exclusions Signs", the following road shall be posted for no thru trucking

1. **Shattigee Road** —from Candia Road to the Raymond Town Line. Tenney Farm Road from the Sandown Town Line on Rte 121 (Haverhill Road).
2. **Lane Road**- In its entirety from 102 (Raymond Road) to Candia Road.
3. **Candia Road** —from Chester Street to the Candia Town Line

Intending that all commercial motor vehicles having a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 pounds or greater shall not be allowed to travel on the subject roads unless making a local pickups or deliveries.

- A. Violations: Any person, firm or corporation violating this By-law shall be guilty of an offense. An offense under this by-law shall constitute a violation.
- B. Penalty: All violations and offenses of this by-law are subject to the appropriate penalties as established by New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated.
- C. Effective Date: The effective day of this by-law shall be the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2003.

This action is taken this 30<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of 2003.


A record of return of this action shall be posted immediately upon its enactment with the Town Clerk.
